Dennis and Charlotte Duffy shared their recent experiences ministering to a family of seven by helping to rebuild their house destroyed by the tornado in Joplin, MO. They stressed that even though the work was physically difficult, the relationships that were built were key elements in helping to change hearts.

Charlotte shared how much she learned about building and using tools, and had pictures to prove it! They provided insight on how to prepare for deployment and also emphasized the need for more volunteers.

Don and Valerie Thorpe shared their experiences in Haiti where they focused on establishing relationships in addition to the hard work to build and install an exhaust hood in the kitchen building. Valerie shared how life changing the experience was for her.

Many great suggestions emerged from the question and answer period from these two reports.

Reflection/Vision

- When sharing blessings of 2011, the main theme from all partners was how they were blessed with the opportunity to meet and work with the other wonderful partners while being part of OperationOC. Many other personal blessings were shared.
- Conversation about what the partners would like to see in 2012 was diverse:
 - Develop regions according to geographic areas
 - Reach out to churches in these geographic areas,
 - Develop OpOC lead for each region
 - Hold regional meeting to reach smaller churches
 - Build out Preparing Together program to provide help to those with access and functional needs
 - Council on Aging may have useful contacts
 - Develop Speakers Board to present OperationOC and preparedness messages to churches and other faith-based groups
 - "Bring a Guest" meeting
 - More frequent EOC trainings were requested
