- 3. Need signage to direct volunteers
- 4. All partners need both the OpOC R and OpOC T radio frequencies
- 5. Need a message center to coordinate all communication
- 6. Need to design a workflow process
- 7. Need a program to keep track of and manage partner resources
- 8. Need runners to deliver messages
